I started working in Atworth Snapdragons last June. The nursery in Atworth was first opened in 1998 by Rose Collard, since then she has opened a further 5 nurseries and will be opening her 7th nursery in Saltford in August of this year.

Atworth nursery has 39 places for 0-5 year olds and we also offer a breakfast club and afterschool club that links to Churchfields School.

During the past year, we have seen an increase in numbers and on some days now we are at capacity numbers.

The children have enjoyed taking part in trips to the farm shop, picnic teas at the local park, a trip to Shurnhold pigs and Dave from there collects apples from our garden for his pigs.

We have also had visits from Maggie our local PCSO, ambulance service, the fire service to name a few.

We have been busy celebrating lots of different festivals and some of you may have seen the children enjoying the Holi celebration, the children enjoyed getting messy with the powder paint throwing in the front garden. We recently walked through the village to the farm shop, staff dressed as bunnies and 20 children dressed as chicks.

We have forest school in the garden, Sportzcoach, music with mummies as well. We have made robust links with Churchfields school, using their sports field, swimming pool and will be soon starting to visit with the September school children. We are always busy in the nursery trying to do different and fun activities.
