When you contacted Atworth Parish Council, the information you provided (personal information such as name, address, email address, telephone number) has been processed and stored so that it is possible for us to contact you and respond to your correspondence and provide requested information regarding Atworth parish Council services. Your personal information will not be shared or provided to any other third party.

The Council's right to process information

Under article 6(1) (a) (b) and (c) of the General Data Protection Regulations, information is processed with consent of the data subject; or processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation; or processing is necessary for the performance of a contract with the data subject or to take steps to enter into a contract.

Information Security

Atworth Parish Council takes care to ensure the security of all personal data. We make sure that your information is protected from unauthorised access, loss, manipulation, falsification, destruction or unauthorised disclosure. This is done through appropriate technological measures and relevant policies. We will only keep your data for the purpose it was collected for, and only for as long as is necessary, after which it will be securely deleted.

YOUR RIGHTS

Access to Information

You have the right to request access to the information we hold on you. You may do this by contacting our Data Information Officer, Philip McMullen clerk@atworth.org

Information Correction

If you believe that the information we hold about you is incorrect, you may contact us in order that we can update it and maintain the accuracy of the data we hold about you. Please contact our Data Information Officer, Philip McMullen clerk@atworth.org

Information Deletion

Right to Object

Rights related to Automated Decision Making and Profiling

Atworth Parish Council does not make use of Automated Decision Making or profiling of any personal data.

Summary

In accordance with the appropriate regulations, we only collect a limited amount of information about individuals, sufficient to be necessary for correspondence, information and service provision. We do not use profiling, we do not sell or pass your data to third parties, and we do not use data for purposes other than which it was intended. We ensure data is stored securely. We delete all data deemed to be no longer necessary. We continually review our Privacy Policies to ensure it is current and suitable for ensuring the protection of your data.
